New planning application

11 Proposed cycle path to Sandling Station

There was a discussion regarding the suggestion to create a cycle path to Sandling Station. The road is in a poor condition in many places and the pavements are often very narrow or non-existent, resulting in the road being very dangerous for pedestrians, including school children. Creating a cycle path would mean narrowing the road still further, which would compound these problems. Given this the Parish Council is unable to support the idea of a cycle path
